Policy Statement

St Joseph's School is committed to providing a safe and caring environment that fosters respect for others and does not tolerate bullying and harassment in any form.

Rationale

St Joseph's School recognises that wellbeing underpins learning. All children have a right to feel safe, secure in the school environment, and online. Definition

Bullying and harassment may be defined as repeatedly causing harm to another person, either physically or psychologically. It may take many forms but it usually demonstrates an imbalanced or unjust use of power. Bullying and harassment is behaviour intended to hurt, humiliate, embarrass, threaten or isolate another, either in person or by using the internet, digital technologies or mobile phones (cyber-bullying).

Responsiblities

The School will ensure that:

- Students, parents and staff are aware of their responsibilities in the Anti-Bullying and Anti-Harassment Policy and Guidelines
- Reports of bullying and harassment are taken seriously, parties are listened to respectfully and incidents are dealt with promptly
- Prevention education is promoted through appropriate programs and activities
- Students, parents and staff are aware of what constitutes bullying: physical, verbal, emotional and psychological, including cyber-bullying
- Students and parents are aware of the procedures for reporting bullying and harassment
- Students and parents are aware of the consequences of engaging in behaviour that constitutes bullying and harassment
